## **CMS Hasche Sigle advises MGPA on acquisition of 140 properties from retailer ALDI-Süd**

Frankfurt/Main – Private equity advisory firm MGPA has acquired a real estate portfolio comprising some 140 properties from ALDI-Süd. The stores, some of which will be leased back to ALDI-Süd, are located primarily in the south and west of Germany. Landbank sites and a distribution centre also form part of the deal. MGPA intends to add the portfolio to the MGPA Europe Fund III. The value of the deal was not disclosed.

A team led by Heinrich Schirmer advised MGPA on all aspects of the transaction.

MGPA is a global private equity advisory firm focusing on real estate investment in Europe and Asia.
